Happy New Year! I hope you had a happy and healthy holiday season. I am writing to you to request your support for my candidacy for the Office of Freeholder at the upcoming Monmouth County Republican Committee Nominating Convention which will take place on February 3rd at iPlay America in Freehold.

With the coming turnover on the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, we will need two strong candidates to run for election this year; one to fill the unexpired term of Freeholder Serena DiMaso who recently was sworn into the New Jersey General Assembly, and another candidate to run for a full three year term. I have served on the Township Committee for the Township of Hazlet since 2014, serving both as Mayor and as Deputy Mayor.

I won reelection in November of 2017, with 57% of the vote against a very well-funded and aggressive Democratic candidate. Our Republican governance is paying dividends in Hazlet. Through our economic development efforts, our highway corridors on Routes 35 and 36 are coming back to life. We've held the line on municipal spending with 0% tax increases in 2016 and 2017. We've created new programs for seniors, students and veterans at no cost to the taxpayers. We're implementing a long term road program after decades of patchwork and procrastination. In partnership with our neighboring municipalities and the grassroots R.A.G.E. organization, we've fought JCP&L's plans to install monster power lines alongside our residential neighborhoods and schools.

I'm ready to bring this kind of leadership and results as a team player and partner to our Freeholder Director Tom Arnone, Deputy Director Lillian Burry and Freeholder Pat Impeveduto. I am committed to keeping Monmouth County a Republican County from top to bottom.

With your support, I will raise the money, knock on the doors, attend the events and generate the media attention needed to win. I humbly ask for your vote at the nominating convention on February 3rd at iPlay America in Freehold.

In partnership with Chairman Golden, Co-Chair Christine Giordano Hanlon, the Vice Chairs, Municipal Chairs, and most importantly—you, we will not let the Democrats gain an inch in Monmouth County.
